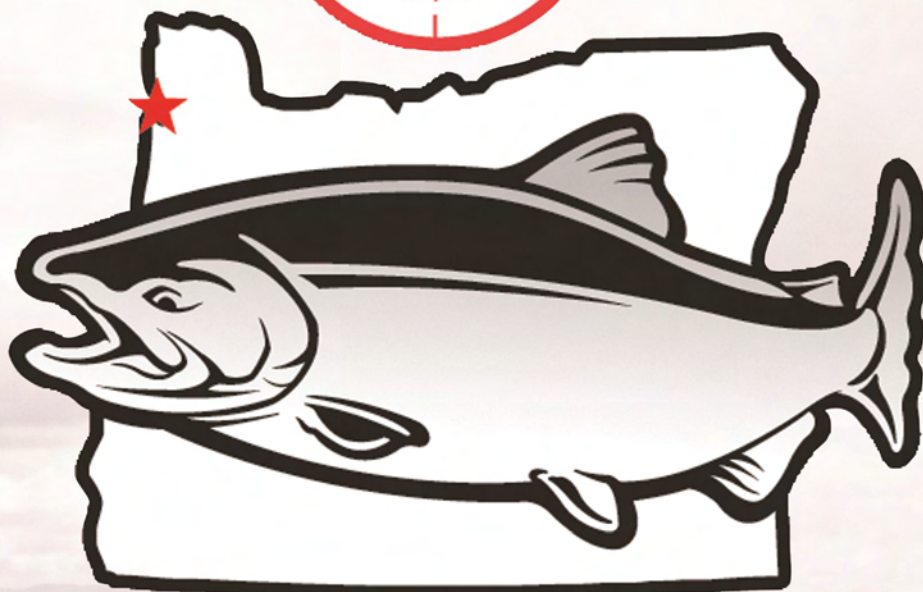

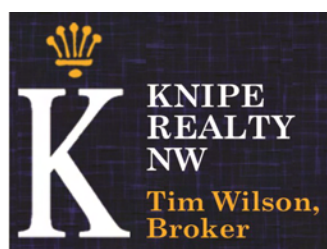

The Tillamook Fairgrounds 4-H Dormitory is available. Bunk house w/bathroom and showers. Three nights, \$50; 2 nights, \$40; 1 night, \$25. RV parking with 15 amp service (no water or waste disposal), \$20 per night, but spaces are limited.

SHOT Rules

- Fishing is limited to Tillamook Bay, Nehalem Bay, and Nestucca Bay watersheds, including their tributaries and any legal "bubble" fishery that is open in the ocean at the mouths of these bays.
- Registration closes at 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, October 13. Fishing starts Friday morning when it is legal to do so and ends Saturday in time to make weigh-in. These regulations are subject to periodic changes. All participants are encouraged to attend Thursday night, and at least one member of each team must be present.
- Fish will be weighed after removal of gills and entrails to the nearest quarter pound. This will allow anglers to keep their catch at the highest quality possible. Take advantage of the law sponsored by the Northwest Steelheaders allowing these fish parts to be disposed of in the waters from which the fish was caught.
- Fish caught on Friday may be weighed that day at the Fairgrounds from 5:00-8:00 p.m. Otherwise, they will need to be weighed in on Saturday, 3:00-5:00 p.m.
- Only legal adult Chinook will be counted for the tournament. Jacks or coho or dark fish (determined by the weighmaster) will not be counted.
- Most weight of fish caught will determine the winning teams. In the event of a tie, the anglers with the most Chinook entered will determine the winner.
- Heaviest single fish weighed will determine the individual largest fish winner. In the event of a tie, the longest fish will determine the winner.
- There will be a prize for the largest sculpin (determined by length) that is brought in Saturday by the weigh-in deadline. In the event of a tie, the fish with the larger girth will determine the winner.
- All questions or disputes regarding these rules will be resolved by the SHOT Chairman.
- Only 3 lines in the water per team and only 5 lines when a skipper/guide is a member of two teams on the same boat. Tournament caps are to be worn.
