ODFW's Aquatic and Angling Education Program staff will host a free training with the Sandy River Chapter of the Association of NW Steelheaders at 6pm – 9pm June 1, 2023, in the Sam Cox Building in the Glenn Otto Community Park, 1102 E. Historic Columbia River Hwy, Troutdale, OR. *This class is 3 hours due to the experience our membership has vs. the usual 5-to-6 hour class.*

The training is open to anyone 18 years of age or older and interested in becoming an ODFW Certified volunteer instructor. Training covers all elements of the program's curriculum including basic fishing skills, stewardship, aquatic resources, and water safety. Participants also learn about events and other volunteer opportunities.

Currently certified instructors are encouraged to attend as the training provides an opportunity to update your knowledge in several areas and network with other volunteers.


