I would like to first thank you for your continued hard work even through these uncertain times. It's your leadership and drive that continues to motivate me and the rest of the office to push forward. The pandemic has provided its share of questionable outcomes, but one thing remains true, ANWS is still here to fight for fish and angler opportunities. Please see below for what the team has been up to:

- Working with state officials, NSIA and CCA on Columbia River Reforms to ensure that ODFW and WDFW would not abandon promises made to anglers by allowing gill nets back on the main stem of the Columbia River.
- Starting to build a broader campaign around breaching the lower four Snake River Dams. A battle that ANWS has been a part of for the last 40+ years, this campaign will continue to be an investment to conserve Columbia River salmon and steelhead opportunities for the next generations to come.
- Providing comments and support of ODFW's proposal to increase fishing opportunities from a boat above Oxbow Park on the Sandy River. If passed, this change will increase fishing opportunities and increase opportunities to catch hatchery fish.
- Working with and urging the ODFW Commission members to once again allow anglers to fish with two rods on the Willamette River. This decision was made without critical thought and a lack of information.
- Engaging the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund Advisory Committee to ensure that this new funding model for ODFW has a presidency on fishery conservation, specifically habitat and fish passage. (If you would like to know more on this topic, please reach out for information).


