Plunking for Shad

Saturday June 5, 2022

Starting at 8am through 2pm, meet us at Clackamette Park, 1955 Clackamette Drive in Oregon City. Larry Palmer, Fish Along Coordinator and Hank Hyde, Fish Along Assistant will be onsite beginning at 8am. Please sign up at our June 1, 2022 Chapter meeting or notify Hank Hyde (503-492-7119) no later than 5pm on June 4, 2022 if you are attending.

Be sure to have a valid Oregon fishing license.

Items to bring: A Chair, A <u>heavy duty rod holder</u> (you want to catch the fish, not have the fish catch your rod and reel), Rain gear or other clothing appropriate for the weather.

- A fishing rod with some backbone, handling 3-8 ounces sinkers, 1 to 3 ounce preferably.
- 10 to 25 lb. test line, and a Salmon size spin cast / casting reel should be fine.
- 6 to 10 pound test leader.
- A 3 way swivel or trolling spreader.
- Lures: Shad Darts, Small thin Wobblers, Triple Teasers, Bouyant or similar.
 Crappie jigs or Steelhead jigs also work.

Arrive at the beach no later than 10:20am.

Be sure to have a valid Oregon Shellfish license. (Shellfish licenses are available at any ODFW license agents/vendors for \$10 (residents) and \$28.00 (non-residents).


Sandy Chapter Annual Family Picnic Saturday, August 20, 2022 at Glenn Otto Park, Troutdale


