
Art, very festive with his turkey hat on, greeted guests at the door. Of course, he was more than happy to sell a raffle ticket or




From the editor.....

#### River Nutrient Revitalization, A.K.A. Toss-A-Carcass

Escaping a fog shrouded North/Northeast Portland early Saturday morning, I burst into glorious sunshine just past 39th on I-84. Arriving at Glenn Otto at about 7:30 a.m., I found Hal Blenn already there. By 8:00 am, the team had gathered with their revitalization tools: wheel barrow, a gardening cart, large blue rolling recycling bin and five gallon buckets. Everyone was decked out in their finest foul weather gear on a perfectly sunny October morning. Obviously, we were ready! The team at this stage of the operation consisted of Brian Rolen, John Bennett, Hal Blenn, Jamie Romaine, Jeremy and me. We headed out for the Ranger Station in Zig Zag to meet up with Jeff Fulop of the ODFW, who already had a busy morning, Brian and John provided the transportation of the team and equipment.

We hooked up with Jeff at the Ranger Station at about 9:00 am. He was waiting with coffee and donuts. Jeff had two totes with approximately 1,000 pounds in each tote of freshly harvested carcasses. We then followed Jeff up the LOLO Pass Road a ways to a day use area, passing multitudes of mushroom hunters on the Zig Zag River. Amazing as it was, most of the carcasses could have been on

someone's dinner table. Literally NO offensive smells! These carcasses had just recently been processed and were now ready to provide nutrients back into the Columbia River systems. The long and short of it we had a great time giving these carcasses a send off. On the way back, we stopped off at the Sandy River Hatchery on Cedar Creek where Jeff gave us a tour of the holding ponds and explained some of the process of the harvesting of the carcasses.

I felt it was a wonderful outing and rewarding experience. I thank everyone who was involved!!


